

Leafy Oaks Campground

You are Responsible to know the Rules and Regulations of this facility.

General Rules:

- Minimum 21 years of age to rent a campsite. Check In is 2 p.m. Check Out is 1p.m. Clean your camp site area before checking out.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Please be considerate of your neighbors.
- No radios after 11 p.m. No Foul Language.
- Children ages 17 and under return to campsite by 11:00 p.m. Playground closes at dark. Beach and swim pond close @ dusk. Golf carts, Bicycles & Pedestrians must have lights after dark.
- Alcoholic beverages are not to be consumed by persons under the age of 21. No use of alcoholic beverages allowed in store or in swimming pond. Any alcohol beverage must be covered with a can holder or cup if you are off of your campsite. Can and bottle holders are available in the camp store.
- Any use of firearms or fireworks is prohibited on the campgrounds. This includes BB guns, air rifles, sling shots and bow & arrows.
- No smoking in the shelter house, camp store, restrooms, at the beach. Put cigarette butts in the fire ring.
- You are responsible for your own children, pets and your guests.
- Children must be under their parents supervision at all times. No children under age 10 are allowed in shower house without an adult.
- Pump outs can be scheduled and paid for in the office. Pump outs on non-scheduled days are \$25.00.
- Absolutely NO refunds. Weather, illness, work, etc. Leafy Oaks is a privately owned campground and we reserve the right to remove any guest or revoke privileges for any reason at any time with no refund whatsoever.
- One camping unit per site. One screened canopy tent is allowed. Tent sites are allowed one tent UNLESS 2nd tent is a pup tent for two small children.
- Trash is to be bagged in 13 gallion sized trash bags (WE DO NOT PICK UP 30 GALLON BAGS.) and placed at the road in the morning
 only. Garbage not to be left out after 4 pm. No household items. We have garbage bags available at the camp store.
- DO NOT PUT GARBAGE (solid waste) IN THE FIRE RINGS. Please do not move the fire rings.

Pets:

- Pets are welcome and must be kept on a leash. No aggressive dogs. No excessive barking in or out of RV.
- Owners <u>MUST</u> clean up after their pets. Pet waste carries disease.
- No pets are allowed in restroom, shower house, shelter house, laundry room or store.
- No pets in swimming area. NO DOGS IN SWIM POND.

Camp Fires:

- Campfires permitted ONLY in fire rings. Please do not move the fire rings. No chainsaws.
- No cutting or damaging of any trees dead or alive will be permitted at any time, regardless of size, type or location.
- Do not fasten anything to any tree anywhere. No permanent clotheslines.
- Firewood is available for sale at the office. Do not put SOLID WASTE, bottles, plastic or cans in fire rings.
- Swim & Fish Ponds: These are the Seneca County Health Department Rules we must enforce.
- You must be 16 years old to swim in the swim pond without adult supervision.
- · No Lifeguard on duty. No swimming alone.
- Swimming hours are from dawn until dusk only. Swim at your own risk. No diving.
- · No glass containers or smoking in the swimming area.
- Dogs may swim in the fishing pond only. Absolutely no fishing with pole & hook in the swim pond.
- Private. No fishing license is required. Fish pond is catch and release only including frogs and turtles.
- Expect to catch: Catfish, Crappe, Bluegill & Bass

Vehicular Traffic:

Speed limit for all vehicles on entire campgrounds is 5 mph.

- Motorcycles are to be used as primary transportation only and confined to roads. Motorbikes, motor scooters, minibikes & ATV's are prohibited. Bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards & roller skates are confined to roads only and are not to be ridden after dark or on the shuffle-board court. You must be at least 16 years of age, have a valid driver license and insurance to drive ANY motorized vehicle in or around the campground.
- Golf Carts are to be registered at the office and receive license plate. Only licensed drivers may drive golf carts and use headlights after dark; no racing or horseplay. No driving in the woods after dark, in grass around swimming area or on the playground. All carts must be at campsite by 11:00 p.m. Violators will lose golf cart privileges for one year.

Security:

· Leafy Oaks is a gated park. No entry after 11:00 pm. If need be, make prior arrangements with store clerk.

Rules and regulations are subject to change without notice.

Leafy Oaks Campground cannot be responsible for injury or damage due to wind, water, fire, or the negligence of you or others. Abusive, drunken, disorderly or offensive behavior will result in removal from the campground. Some of these rules were made by our insurance carrier, some by the State of Ohio and some adjusted based on a review of camping policies of other campgrounds.
